Tom is seeking the pinball champion. A₂

Tom is seeking the Mayor of Dunedin
Tom found the Mayor of Dunedin

The Mayor of Dunedin exists. A₃

Tom is seeking the Mayor of Dunedin
Tom did not find the Mayor of Dunedin

The Mayor of Dunedin exists. A₄

Tom found the Mayor of Dunedin
The Mayor of Dunedin is the pinball champion

Tom found the pinball champion. A₅
